OVERVIEW

Do you know who revolutionized fashion photography in the 60s?

Ovation has teamed with Shine International for this original production which tells the story of famed British photographer, David Bailey (Aneurin Barnad) and his model and muse, Jean Shrimpton (Karen Gillan of *Dr. Who*).

Bailey is a brash young photographer with no formal training, that landed a job at *British Vogue*. He came to New York with his unrefined model, Jean Shrimpton, blowing the old guard away. The visionary Bailey refused to conform to the status quo. His raw, sophisticated images of the gamine Shrimpton revolutionized the world of fashion photography and remain iconic today.

The photos that resulted from the 1960 *Vogue* shoot had Shrimpton posing in haute couture set against the mean gritty streets of New York City, while clutching a teddy bear. This became the definition of a new generation of celebrity chic – one which helped characterize the cinema verite style and focused on the contrast and grey area of what “beautiful” actually is.

We'll Take Manhattan illustrates the rebellious spirit of these characters and also focuses on the torrid love affair that inevitably ensued.
